Sharp's unique Composer feature offers flexibility in combining multiple document types into a single document for simple printing and/or distribution. No more cutting and pasting from multiple applications! Simply select the documents, reorder the pages, add a cover page and then print or distribute them instantly.

➤ How does scanning provide storage and RETRIEVAL advantages?

The benefits of scanning are immediately realized in cost and time savings. Rather than needing to store volumes of printed files, documents can be scanned into digital format and filed electronically on desktop PCs, network servers and/or removable media.
